



Holiday Art Camps at St Anne's 2026/27

St Anne's Catholic Primary School has been successfully running Art Camps during the school holidays since 2022.

The aim of the camps is to provide a safe space for children to explore their artistic talents which is cost effective for working parents or indeed parents who just need to take a well earned rest. The camp is offered to both St Anne's children and those from other schools from Years Reception-Year 6

The camp is run by a qualified teacher - Ms Dimech and supported by school staff each day the camp runs



Location, Dates & Times 2026/27

The holiday camp is run from our school - St Anne's Catholic Primary School, Free Prae Road, Chertsey, KT16 8ET. The main part of the day is held in fully air conditioned classrooms and the children also have the opportunity to have breaks outside using our large grounds and play equipment.

Each day the camp will run from 8:30am-4:30pm. Drop off is between 8:30-9am and pick from 4-4:30pm

Price, Booking & Payment

The Art Camp costs £35 per child/per day if booked and paid before the cut off date. We will accept late bookings and on the day bookings but these will be charged at £38 per child/per day.

If your child is a current pupil at our School all dates are available for you to book on the Arbor Parent Portal.

If your child attends any other school you book using the below forms, there is one form for each holiday period to help us effectively manage up to date contact information and medical needs for safeguarding purposes.

On the Day of your booking



Arrival and collection

The Holiday camp runs on all the dates stated in this booklet from 08:30-4:30pm. Drop off is between 8:30-9am and collection between 4-4:30pm.

It is important that your child is dropped off and collected within these times. This allows us to ensure your child(ren) are supervised at all times and are kept safe.

Please drop your child at the middle gate of the front playground, one of the staff members will be in the playground to greet them and check their names on the register.

Collection will be from the same place in the front playground. Children will only be allowed to leave with the persons listed as OK to collect in Arbor or provided to us, so update us with additional people if needed.

Please do advise us if your child is unable to attend by emailing Ms Dimech ldimech@stannes-chertsey.surrey.sch.uk. We will follow normal safeguarding rules for attendance as we would on a normal school day. i.e. if we are expecting your child to attend and they do not and we have not heard from you as to why we will take steps to confirm where your child is and if necessary report your child as missing.

Parking

You may briefly park onsite to drop or collect your child.

Clothing

The children will be having lots of messy fun, as well as having breaks outside in the playground (weather permitting). Please ensure your child is dressed appropriately for the activities. Depending on the weather, they may need to bring a sun hat and apply sun cream at home before attending or indeed bring a coat or woolly jumper. We recommend old clothes are worn.

If you feel your child may need spare clothes please bring these in a bag with everything labelled!

What to bring

Please bring a packed lunch, snacks and a drink in a refillable drinks bottle. Please note we cannot provide any snacks or food so you will need to provide all snacks bearing in mind the length of the day. All food must be nut free.

We recommend packing an old shirt or apron with your child's name on it.

Medication

If your child requires medication; an EpiPen, inhalers or any other medication please bring this in a clearly labelled bag and hand it to the teacher at the start of the day, it will be returned to you at the end of each day.

Please Note – The school medication cupboard is not accessible in the holidays so all required medications must be brought from home.

If your child does have any medical conditions we must be informed. It is very important that you have provided at least two emergency contacts numbers are available in case of emergency.

Behaviour

We want everyone to have fun, learn and be creative during their time at the Holiday Camp.

Our school values are inclusivity, respect, perseverance, kindness and forgiveness. We model children's behaviour around these values and the same will apply during the school holidays at the camp.

Please speak to your child to let them know that the same behaviour is expected at the camp as at school.

You will be contacted if your child's behaviour becomes detrimental to the enjoyment and participation of the other children attending. You will need to collect your child immediately and depending on the severity they may not be able to continue with any future days booked.

Due to restricted staffing numbers we are not able to offer one to one supervision for children attending the camp. If you feel that this would be needed for your child this might not be the right setting for you during the holidays. We are more than happy to discuss individual needs with you before you book.

Emergency contact and Safeguarding

If you need to contact the school while your child are here please call the school mobile on 07834 982943. This number should only be used for emergency contact regarding the current Art Camp. Please note the number will only be monitored from the morning of the first day of the camp and on the days and times the camp is running.

Terms & Conditions

Booking

Children must not be left without a booking.

For St Anne's Pupils this must be on Arbor before the deadline.

For all other children this must be made using the correct Microsoft Form.

For everyone - St Anne's Pupils and non St Anne's pupils - any bookings made after the deadline will require parents to complete a manual form at the gate on the first day the child attends the relevant camp.

There are no exceptions to this as it directly relates to the safety of the children and the ability for the staff to contact parents and guardians in an emergency.

Payment

The fee of £35 per child per day must be paid before the deadline date and time for each camp. Failure to pay in full will result in the place being cancelled. After this, only on the day bookings can be made charged at £38 per child per day.

No refunds are offered for non attendance and the dates are not transferable outside of the camp a booking was made.

On the day bookings must be paid in cash or via bank transfer with evidence shown to staff at the gate before the child is left.

For this reason advanced booking is highly recommended.

Drop off & Collection

Children must be dropped off and collected on time. Drop off between 8:30 and 9am and collection between 4pm and 4:30pm.

Absences must be reported using the contact information in this booklet. If a child is booked but does not attend our Xavier First Day Response Process will be followed until contact is made. This could result in a referral to Children's Services.

Behaviour & Policies

Behaviour expectations are the same as during the normal school day. All school policies apply during Art Camp and can be found on the school website, with links to the relevant Xavier policies where appropriate.
