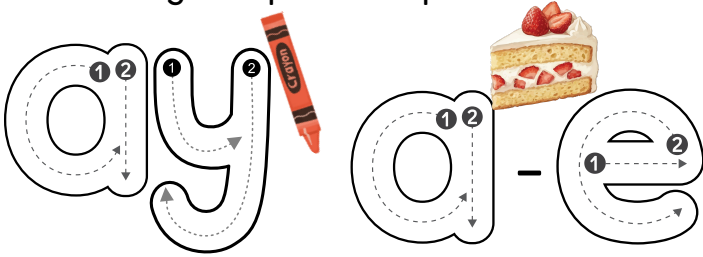

In Phonics, we will be learning:

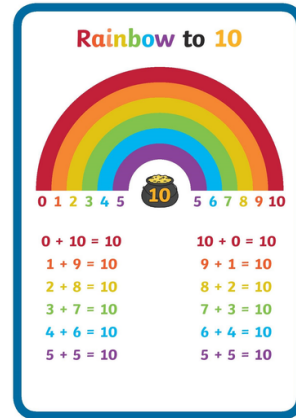
- 'ay' as in crayon
