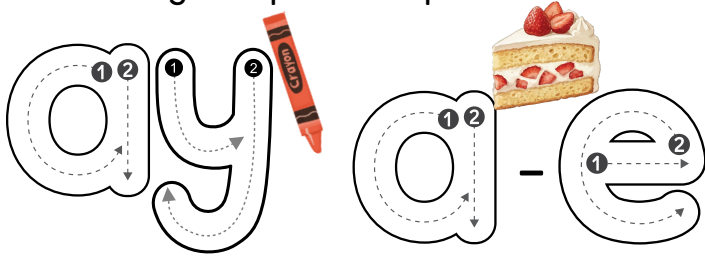
Next week, we will be learning...

- 'a-e' as in cake

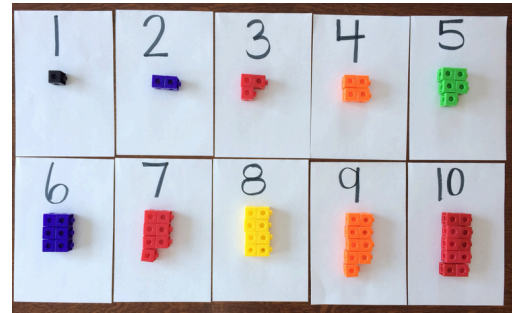
Please spend some time looking at these in your phonics practise book.
