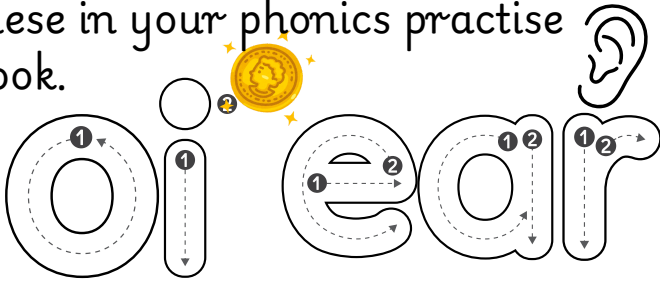
Next week, we will be learning...

- 'ear' as in ear.

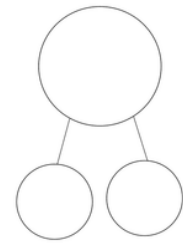
Please spend some time looking at these in your phonics practise book.
