Reminder:

We are delighted to share that this half term we will once again continue our long-standing collaboration with St George's College, Weybridge—a partnership that has always been a truly enriching experience.

Throughout the half term, Upper Sixth Form students will visit the Reception children every Thursday morning for eight weeks to lead RE learning as part of their A Level course. These sessions will be supported by all Reception staff and accompanied by a St George's teacher. Each week will feature singing, games, and creative activities.

Thursday 12th March - Final Celebratory Mass

The programme will conclude on Thursday 12th March, where the Reception children and staff are invited to a special celebratory Mass at St George's College in Weybridge.

Reception staff and children will travel together by coach, and the children will perform one of the songs they have learnt, in front of the other local Catholic schools who also share the partnership. - 'z' as in zebra

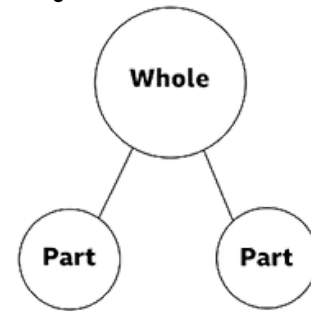
Please do spend some time looking at these in your phonics practise book.
