We aim to use our outdoor area all year round.

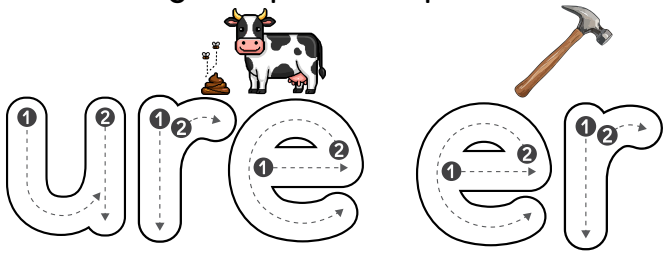
Next week, we will be learning...

LITERACY

In Phonics, we will be learning:

- 'ure' as in manure
- 'er' as in hammer

Please spend some time looking at these in your phonics practise book.



MATHS

The children will be:

- identify number bonds to 10.
- using subtraction to identify a missing part to 10.
- using number bonds to identify missing parts.

$$10 - 3 = 7 \quad 10 - 5 = 5$$
$$10 - 1 = 9 \quad 10 - 4 = 6$$
