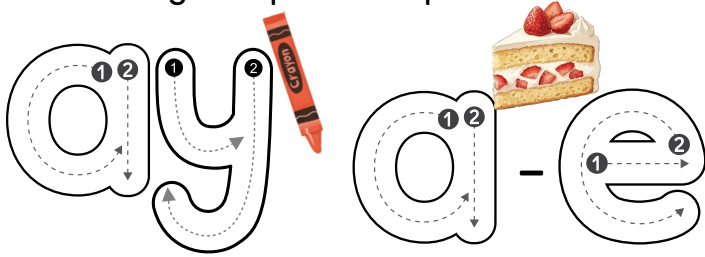
Next week, we will be learning...

- 'a-e' as in cake

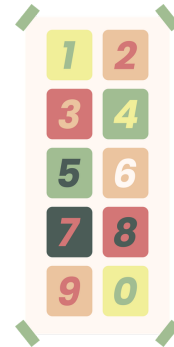
Please spend some time looking at these in your phonics practise book.

Objective 3: We are all invited to be a friend of Jesus.



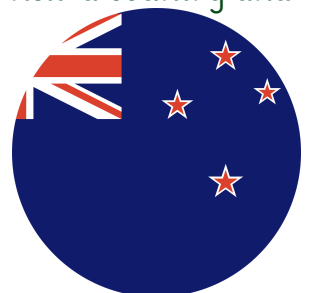
UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD
