Open Morning / Afternoon

We would like to invite you in to school to see the wonderful work your children do on a daily basis.

On Friday 22nd March, we will be holding a coffee morning for all parents to attend after drop-off at 9.00am in the cabin classroom.

At 9.30am, anyone who is interested in watching a live phonics session in Reception and Year 1, are warmly invited to walk around the classes to see how the sessions work in action! This is to observe and not an opportunity for talking as the children will be deep in learning! This will last approximately 15-20 minutes.

At 2.30pm, all parents are invited into their child's class to view one piece of work their child has selected to look at with you. The gates will be open shortly before and you will be asked to sign in as you enter any classroom.

If you have more than one child to see, please attend the older siblings class first and then they will be able to take you along to your other child/children. When the bell rings at 2.55pm, we would then ask you to leave the classroom and wait in the playground, as usual, until the end of the day.



Our learning next week...

<u>In Phonics we will be learning...</u>

We will be continuing to understand and recognise digraphs (when two letters come together to make one sound). Next week, we will be introducing trigraphs (when three letters come together to make one sound).

- Sounds: **ee, igh** and **oa**
- Reading and writing CVC words eq: boat, sigh, sheep
- Writing simple sentences with a capital letter, finger space and full stop eq: The boat is red.

Length, Height and Time

- Explore length
- Compare length
- Explore height
- Compare height
- Talk about time
- Order and sequence time

Communication and Language

To develop the children's communication, language and vocabulary, each week we introduce two new words related to our topic that can be found in our book of the week. Next week our words of the week will be:
