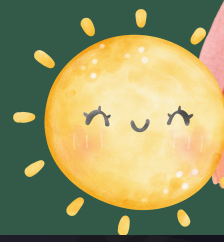

Tuesday 21st October and Thursday 23rd October - Parents Evening (more information to follow)



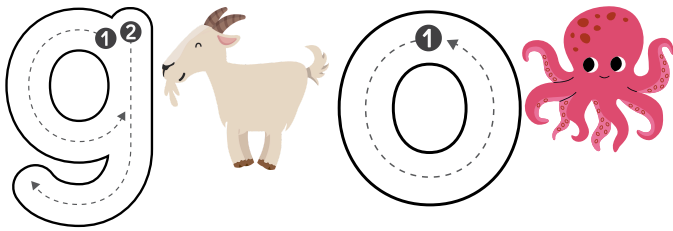
Next week, we will be learning...

- 'o' as in octopus.

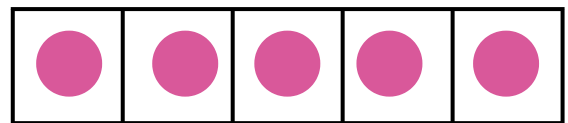
Please do spend some time looking at these in your phonics practise book.
