# Our learning next week...

#### **Phonics:**

- Sounds: w and x
- Letter formations: w and x
- Reading and writing words with the sounds in that we have learnt so far
- Reading and writing sentences with capital letters, finger spaces and full stops

#### In Maths we will be...

- gaining a deep understanding of numbers 6-10. This involves recognising, ordering and writing the digits, matching and comparing amounts of objects to 10, counting forwards and backwards to 10' and the composition of each number e.g. 5 is made up of 2 and 3 and 4 and 1
- naming, recognising and drawing shapes with 4 sides

- We will be learning all about the Three Wise Men and the presents they gave Baby Jesus.
