We aim to use our outdoor area all year round.

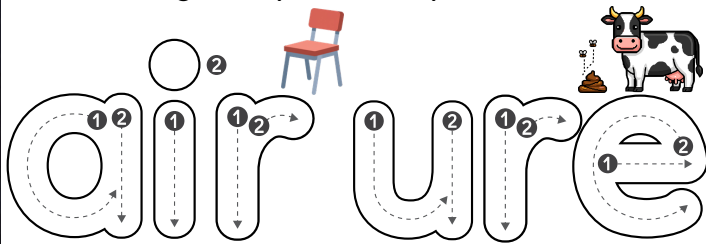
Next week, we will be learning...

- 'ure' as in manure.

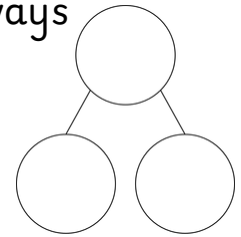
Please spend some time looking at these in your phonics practise book.
