Some suggestions for these boxes:

EYFS, Year 1, Year 2 and Year 3 children

We would like to ask these pupils to make a box up for a child, which will be given to local children at Chertsey food bank, children at the Shooting Star Hospice and children of families at Princess Alice Hospice. We know this will mean a great deal to these children.

Some suggestions for these boxes:

- Dolls, toy trucks, harmonica, yo-yo, skipping rope, ball, small puzzles etc.
- Pens, pencils & sharpeners, crat sets, crayons or felt pens, stamps & ink pad sets, writing pads or notebooks & paper, calculators, colouring & picture books, stickers etc.
- > Toothbrush, bars of wrapped soap, comb or hairbrush, flannel, slippers, water bottles, blankets
- Hat, cap, gloves or scarf, sunglasses, hair accessories, jewellery set, wind up torch, wrapped sweets

Key Points:

- If your child is making a box for a child, we suggest they make up a box for a child of their own age.
- After the box is packed and wrapped, please put a sticker/piece of paper on top with the **gender** the box is for and for children the **age** it is aimed for.
- **Do Not** include used or damaged items, medicines, sharp objects, glass containers, or fragile items.
- Your child might want to write a card or message to the recipient.
