November is the month of

Remembrance in the Catholic Church, and in this way, we end the liturgical year. On All Souls Day we especially recall the names of those parishioners who have died during the last 12 months. We assure their families that we join in prayerful solidarity with them. We open our:

November Book of Remembrance

'All who die in God's grace and friendship, but still imperfectly purified, are indeed assured of their eternal salvation; but after death they undergo purification, so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of heaven.' (Catechism of Catholic Church: par.1030)

November is the month we traditionally pray for those who have died. All parishioners, and all who come to pray and worship here, are invited to enter into the November Book of Remembrance the names of family, friends, and loved ones who have died, wherever they have lived their lives. We then pray for them during the eucharist that any purification still to be undergone may soon be complete.
