## **First Reconciliation and Holy Communion Programme 2024.**

The programme is *family based* - each candidate will be required to attend 12 weekly facilitated sessions with at least one parent/guardian supporting them every session. The programme will run from January to June 2024 weekly, apart from school holidays.

The **Parent's Evening will be held on 23rd November 2023 at 7-30 p.m. in the Savio Centre. It is compulsory** that at least one parent attends this information evening.

On the weekend of the 21<sup>st</sup> January 2024 the candidates and families will be enrolled in the programme and parishioners will be asked to pray for your family's journey to a deeper loving relationship with Jesus Christ.
