First Reconciliation and Holy Communion Programme 2024.

The programme is *family based* - each candidate will be required to attend 12 weekly facilitated sessions with at least one parent/guardian supporting them every session. The programme will run from January to June 2024 weekly, apart from school holidays.

The **Parent's Evening will be held on 23rd November 2023 at 7-30 p.m. in the Savio Centre. It is compulsory** that at least one parent attends this information evening.

On the weekend of the 21st January 2024 the candidates and families will be enrolled in the programme and parishioners will be asked to pray for your family's journey to a deeper loving relationship with Jesus Christ.
