**The Fourth Sunday of Lent is 'Laetare Sunday' and we honour Mothers' Day. Children from year 3 at St Anne's school will make a presentation and lead our intercessions.**

During the fourth week of Lent we celebrate the **Feast of St Patrick (17<sup>th</sup> March)** and the **Solemnity of St Joseph (19<sup>th</sup> March)** the second principal patron of the Salesian Society. Two masses on the 19<sup>th</sup> ~but the day is not a holy day of obligation.

**Salesian House are looking for an experienced Cook** to work in our resident community for Catholic priests and brothers in Chertsey, providing home cooked evening meals. Our Cooks are responsible for planning, coordinating and providing appropriate catering for the residents in consultation with the Rector.
