# Spelling Activities

Spelling is improved when reading is done.

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Of course words are magic. That's why they call it spelling.

This guide is designed to help you to understand a little more about the development of spelling skills. It aims to provide practical guidance on how you can support your child at home.



ABC Order - Write all of your spelling words in alphabetical (ABC) order.



Word Parts - Write your words. Then use a coloured pencil to divide the words into syllables. e.g. jumping caterpillar

Other Handed - Write each word 5 times, switching the hand you write it with each time. Say the word as you spell it.

**Vowel Spotlight** - Write your words using one colour for the vowels and another colour for the consonants.

(vowels: a, e, i, o, u)

**Use Technology** - Type out your spelling words on the computer. Try to use at least 4 different fonts.



**Rainbow Words** - Write your spelling words with coloured pencils. Make each letter a different colour.

out of a newspaper or
magazine and gluing the
letters on a piece
of paper to spell your words.

Scrambled Words - Write your words. Then write them again with the letters mixed up. Can you unscramble them again the next day?

e.g. watch - cwhta

**Silly Sentences** - Write 3 or more sentences that use all your spelling words.



**Picture & a Story** - Draw a picture defining each word. Write a sentence about your picture using the word.

#### Prefixes and Suffixes -

Underline the prefixes and suffixes in the words you are learning. Make sure you know what the mean.

e.g. <u>important</u>
happi<u>ness</u>

Word Search - Create your own word search with your spellings. Show the answers to your puzzle in a different colour.



**Picture words** - Draw a picture and hide your spelling words in the picture.

Flashcards - Make and Practice with flashcards. Put the word on one side and definition (meaning) on the other.

Words without Vowels -

Write all of your words replacing vowels with a line. Go back and see if you can fill in the vowels.

Flash Cards

e.g. q--st--n = question

**Train Words** - Write the entire list end-to-end as one long word. Write each new word in a different colour.

e.g. trainbackstop

Write a Story, Poem or Song with Words - Write a story using all your spelling words. Underline the words you used.

#### **Bubble Letters** -

Write your
Spelling words
out in bubble
writing.



#### Words Within Words -

Write each spelling word and then write at least 2 words made from that word. e.g. catch - cat, hat

Question/Answers - Write Questions with half of your Spelling words. Then use the other half to answer the questions. Underline the words you used.



Riddles - Write a riddle for each of your words. Don't forget to answer them.
e.g. I am grey. I have a trunk and big ears.
Answer: elephant.



Crossword Puzzle - Make a crossword puzzle with your spelling. Show the answers to your puzzle.



Rhyming Words - Write your spelling words out with a rhyming word next to them. Remember that words do not need to have the same spelling pattern to rhyme.

e.g. men and again

Backwards Words - Write your spelling words forwards and then backwards. Remember to write neatly.

Homophones - Can you find any homophones which go with your spelling words?
What do they mean?
e.g. wear and where, to, too and two their, there and they're

Writing Race - Set a timer for 2 minutes. See how many times you can write each word perfectly during that time.



**Code Words** - Come up with a code for each letter of the alphabet and then write each word in code.

e.g.  $a = \Box b = \blacklozenge c = \spadesuit$ 

Word Classes - Sort your spelling words into word classes - nouns, verbs, adjectives etc. Be careful - some words can be used in more than one category e.g. swimming.

**Antonyms** - Find an antonym (opposite) for each of your spelling words.



Synonyms -

Find at least 2 synonyms for each of your spelling words.



Joker - Write jokes containing each of your spelling words.

Backwards Words - Write your spelling words forwards and then backwards. Remember to write neatly!

**X Words** - Write 2 words with one letter in common so that they cross over each other.

Three Times - Write each spelling word three times. Firstly, write each word in pencil. Secondly, write each word in crayon. Thirdly, write each word in marker. You MUST write neatly!

Acrostic Poem - Write an acrostic poem for your spelling words. See if you can stick to a theme when writing.

e.g. sun
Sun shines brightly
Up in the sky
Nice and warm on my face

Adding my Words - Each letter has a value.
\*Consonants are worth 10.
\*Vowels are worth 5.
Write your spelling words.
Then add up the value of each spelling word.
Example:

said - 10 + 5 + 5 + 10 = 30

Scrabble - In a game of
Scrabble, each letter is worth
a certain number of points.
Write your words and then
add the total of the letters.
Which of your spelling
words has the
highest total value?



UPPER and Lower - Write your words one time with all uppercase letters and one time with all lowercase letters.
