This new curriculum is structured around six foundational branches: Creation and Covenant, Prophecy and Promise, Galilee to Jerusalem, Desert to Garden, To the Ends of the Earth, and Dialogue and Encounter. The Diocese continues to support our teachers and leaders with high-quality professional development and guidance, ensuring that your children receive the very best Catholic Religious Education, rooted in scripture and tradition.



Creation and Covenant



During this half-term, pupils will encounter the God who creates and calls a people. They will explore revelation of the Christian belief that all that is comes from God, the Creation accounts in Genesis, and scientific explanations of the process of Creation. They will explore the call of God and his covenantal relationship with his people first through Abraham and Moses, then through the narrative of the Old Testament.

We are continuing to embed the principles of Catholic Social Teaching into the heart of our school community. Each week, we will be focusing on a different principle, such as Dignity of the Human Person or Care for God's Creation. 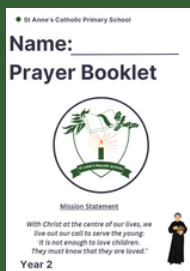
