1. Phonics book (page 46 and 47). **ge** as in package, **σ** as in mother

2. Reading

Please read with your child every night and write in their reading diary. We expect children to read to an adult for at least 10 minutes 5x per week but preferably every evening. Books are changed on Mondays but they should be in school every day with their reading diaries.

Each week, children will be given:

- A physical rocket phonics book. The colour of this is chosen based on the sounds they know from our assessments in class.

- Physical reading for pleasure books. These books are picked by the children to maintain a love of reading. Children don't have to read these independently; they can have these books read to them.
3. Key vocabulary. Please read these and consider whether your child knows the meaning of these words we will be covering in lessons.
