2. Reading



Each week, children will be given:

- A physical <u>rocket phonics book</u>. The colour of this is chosen based on the sounds they know from our assessments in class.
- Physical reading for pleasure books. These books are picked by the children to maintain a love of reading. Children don't have to read these independently; they can have these books read to them.
