Dear Parents / Carers,

We all hope you have a wonderful, relaxing and peaceful Easter.

Please find attached the Year 1 curriculum map for this term which will give you an outline of our learning.

In RE, we are continuing with the scheme of work called 'Come and See' which the Diocese has recommended. Our three topics this term are, 'Holy Days and Holidays', 'Being Sorry' and 'Neighbours'.

After Easter, we will continue to have PE on a Thursday afternoon and the children can continue to come into school wearing their PE kit. Please remember that  ${\bf no}$  jewellery is allowed on these days as recommended in the Surrey Guidelines. Full PE kit is expected, which includes a pair of white socks, green shorts or skirt, dark track suit bottoms (optional), white T – shirt, plimsolls or trainers. Please could you also ensure that **ALL** uniform and kit is clearly named.

Music lessons with Mrs Houslander will continue on Thursdays and ICT lessons with Mrs Gauthier will be on alternate Thursday mornings.

Please could we also ask you to continue to hear your child read daily <u>and</u> please sign the yellow reading record so we know they have been heard. In particular, can you try to ensure that you leave time to discuss and understand what he/she has read and any new words that come up to improve their level of comprehension. <u>Reading books and reading diaries must be brought into school every day.</u> We will continue to send homework out on a Friday.

Finally, could we please remind you that each child must bring in a **named water bottle each day**. This is particularly important this term, when the weather gets hotter (hopefully!), so that the children keep properly hydrated. Breaktime snacks should also be healthy – a piece of fruit or sliced vegetables – no sugary snacks are permitted - and only water to drink. Children should also bring a <u>named</u> cap/hat to wear outside at playtimes and a waterproof coat/jacket on duller days.
