WELCOME TO YOUR FINAL TERM IN YEAR 2!

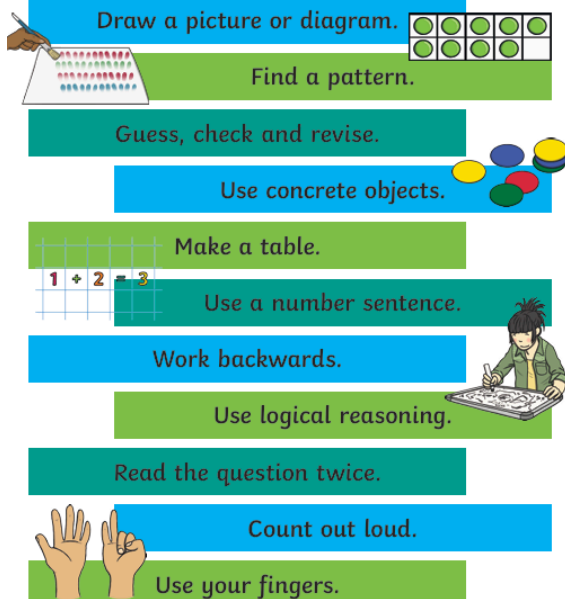
Welcome to the final term of Year 2. We cannot believe how quickly the year has gone, and we are so proud of everything the children have achieved so far.

The children's enthusiasm, kindness, and joy makes every day special, and it is a privilege to support them as they learn and grow.

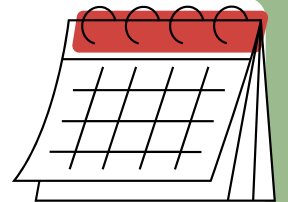

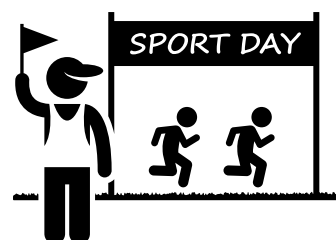
