Science

Light

- To recognise that light is needed to see things and that darkness is the absence of light
- Notice that light is reflected from surfaces
- Light from the sun can be dangerous and that there are ways to protect our skin and eyes
- To understand how shadows are formed and find patterns in the way that the size of the shadow changes

- Explore the requirements of plants for life and growth
- Identify the functions of different parts of flowering plants
- Explore the part that flowers play in the life cycle of flowering plants

History

Britain's settlement by Anglo-Saxons and Scots
