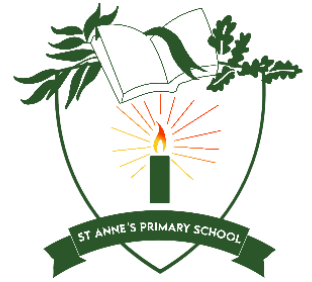

Dear Parents and Carers,

The Year 4 children will be visiting Chertsey Museum to support their learning about the British Empire and the Victorian era. Due to limited space at the museum, each class will attend on a different day:

- **Tuesday 5th May – St Jane**
- **Wednesday 6th May – St Carlo**

During the visit, the children will take part in an object-based session using both replica and original Victorian artefacts. Activities will include role-play, dressing up, and art. The focus will be on comparing the lives of rich and poor Victorian children, exploring their home life, work, and schooling. This will help the children understand how challenging life was for many children during this period.

The trip will take place during the school day. We will leave school at 9:00am and return by 2:45pm.

Children should wear full school uniform and bring a healthy packed lunch in a named, disposable bag (no nuts, fizzy drinks, glass bottles, or sweets). If your child normally has a school meal, please remember to cancel it for that day. Please note: The museum has specifically requested disposable lunch bags due to limited storage space.

We kindly request a voluntary contribution of £5.80 per child, which covers the cost of the museum-led sessions. Please make payment via Scopay, which will also serve as your consent for your child to attend. If insufficient contributions are received, we may unfortunately need to cancel the trip. Please ensure payment is made by Monday 1st May 2026.

There is a small gift shop at the museum. If you wish your child to purchase a souvenir, we suggest sending no more than £5.00 in a named purse or wallet, which they will be responsible for throughout the day.
