
Dear Parents,

As you are aware, we are required to teach RSE (Relationships and Sex Education) to your children and we follow a Catholic Scheme called "Journey in Love", which has been endorsed by the Bishop.

In this year's science curriculum, which overlaps RSE, we will be doing Animals including Humans which is about the human life cycle. As part of this learning in science, children will be learning about the stages of a baby's development from fertilisation to a 1 year old and children will also be learning about puberty. In science, the learning will be about the sequence of the changes of the human body throughout its life cycle.

In our first lessons, we have covered the social and emotional changes children go through, as they become teenagers. Our next lesson will be going into the physical changes that children go through during puberty including the menstrual cycle. This will be in the week commencing 25.03.2024.

We will teach this to the boys and girls separately. Please see below the key words of the Year 5 RSE curriculum so that you are aware of the vocabulary we will be using and if you wish you could discuss these words with your child.
