

Dear Parents/Guardians,

We hope this message finds you well.

From the week commencing 20<sup>th</sup> May, we ask that the children change into their PE kit at school for their Monday PE Lesson.

It is hoped that changing at school will support the children's transition to secondary school, where they must be prepared for and change before PE lessons.

Therefore, we ask that the children bring their full PE kit into school on a Monday in a named bag.

When getting changed, the children will be separated by gender. Girls will change in 6E whereas boys will change in 6S.

The children will return home in their PE kits to allow lesson time to be utilised.

If your child cannot yet tie their shoelaces, the Easter holidays will provide the perfect opportunity to practice this skill.
