Residential Trip: Henley Fort (8-10 June 2026)

We are pleased to share that it is once again the exciting time of year when we begin preparations for our annual Year 6 residential, which will take place towards the end of the academic year.

By **10th December**, we kindly request **confirmation of your child's attendance**. This will be recorded through the **payment of a £20 deposit via Scopay**, which will be deducted from the final balance. Please note that this deposit is non-refundable.

Before making this payment, we would like to provide further information about the residential to support you in making an informed decision.

The programme involves pupils taking part in a range of adventurous outdoor activities. In previous years, these have included rock climbing, orienteering, canoeing and archery, among others. Pupils also stay in traditional Mongolian yurts, which have consistently been one of the favourite elements of the trip. All meals, except lunch on the first day, are provided by the on-site catering team.

Importantly, no specialist clothing or equipment is required for this residential. Aside from the cost of the trip itself, no further expenses will be incurred. A kit list with recommended clothing and personal items will be sent to you in due course.

Please note that drop-off on the day of the trip will take place as usual. We also endeavour for collection to be at the usual time of 3:15pm.
