**growth**-process of increasing in size

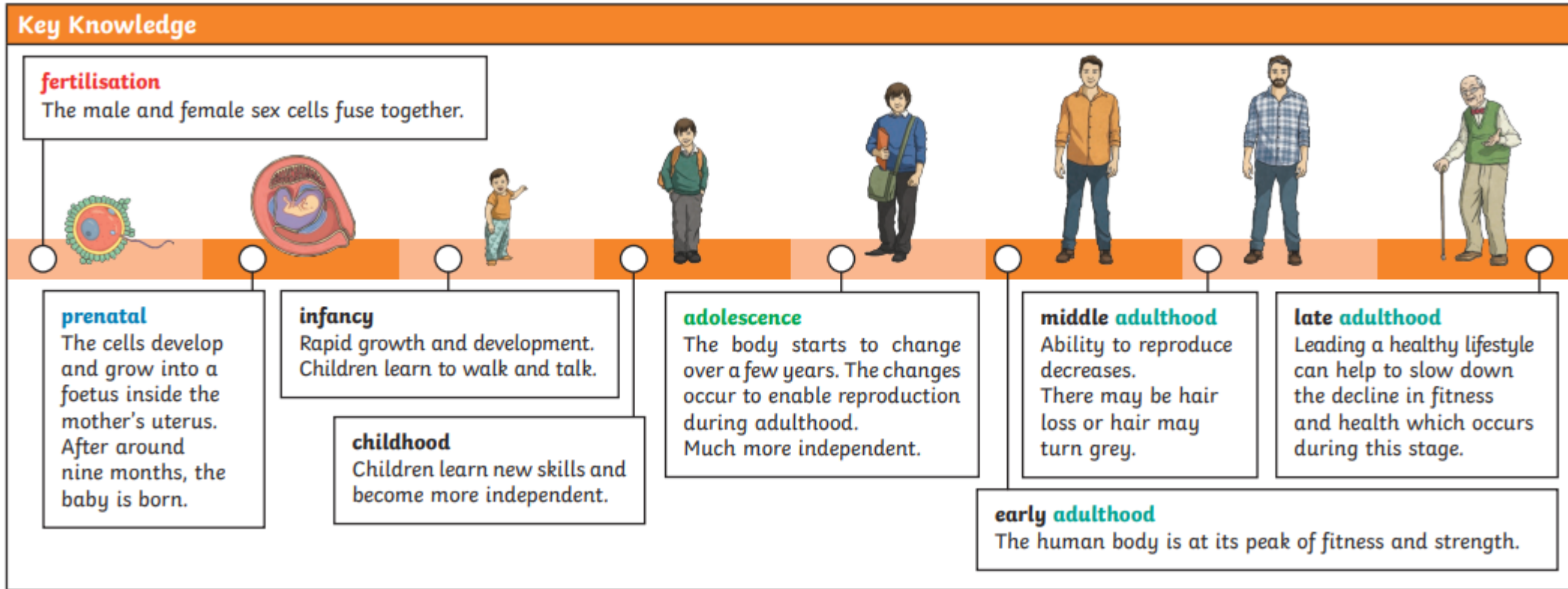
**survive**- to live

**Key learning**
