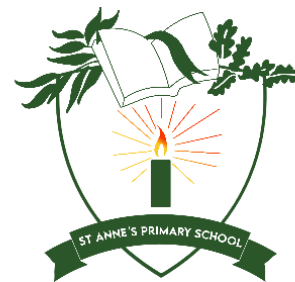

Dear Parents,

Can you believe that the children are about to commence the final term in their primary education? We are so proud of the maturity, perseverance and commitment that the children have shown so far this year. Outlined below are some details of the coverage in the summer term.

R.E.

We continue to follow the Come and See scheme, as recommended by the Diocese. The topics include: Witnesses, Healing and Common Good.

English

We will continue to build up the children's portfolio of writing, as you know this is teacher assessed. Reading skills and grammatical understanding will also continue to be taught.

Maths

We will focus on developing the children's skills in applying their mathematical knowledge to problem solving and reasoning. We ask that the children evidence at least three entries in their Maths diary every week - this could be linked to the week's learning or to address areas for development.

Science

Our topics this term are: Evolution and Inheritance and Classifying Living Things.

Geography

During these sessions we will begin work on our USA topic - 'Land of the Free' which will build up their skills in this subject through a study of this area of the world. We also hope to look into some of the history of the USA.

Art/ DT

Our Art will link to our Geography topic. In DT the children will also be given the opportunity to make bread.

P.E

PE will continue to be on Fridays. All pupils need continue to wear their PE kit to school for these sessions. As the weather brightens up the children also need to ensure they have applied sun cream before coming to school.

Homework

The children are becoming increasingly independent which will really benefit them in their lead up to secondary school. Your child should also ensure they are reading for at least 20 minutes every day. We will continue to monitor their Accelerated Reader minutes on a weekly basis.
